On July 21, after a short illness Mr Leslie Ford, Deputy General Manager, NAC, died in Wellington Hospital. He was 59 and due to retire in November.

Before the war Mr Ford worked in the Government Audit Office and then served overseas with the RNZAF. Between 1941 and 1945 he was a prisoner of war and shortly before his illness had enjoyed a reunion with POW friends.
