Tree Planting at Phillips Reserve, Nelson



The chairman of the Nelson Section, Mr Frank Alack, and another member inspecting recently planted seedling trees in the Society's Phillips Reserve, on the banks of the Sherry River some 45 miles from Nelson. Last year members of the Nelson Section planted

hundreds of native trees on the reserve, an area presented to the Society by Mrs W. Blowes. It is expected that the complete plantings of trees will take several years to finish and that eventually the reserve will become one of the show places of Nelson.
